SUMMER EXHIBITION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All Exhibiting Members in good standing may submit two works. All entries must be the artist's original work. Works copied from another artist or under the supervision of an instructor; from a picture or photograph appearing in print using the composition or essential art elements are not considered original work. Artwork executed in a workshop is not eligible. Photo reproduction of completed original works will not be accepted. Only original prints hand pulled by the artist intended as final work can be accepted. Please note at this time Video/film will be accepted but artist must supply all equipment.

All works must be professionally presented and ready to hang.

Year of Production: All work submitted must have been created after January 1, 2021 and not previously shown in a BSA exhibition. This includes in gallery and virtual exhibitions of the BSA.

Work Size: The framed or 3-D size of your work may not exceed 40" in any direction. Pedestals are available.

Entry Fee: \$30 non-refundable, payable at time of entry via PayPal.

Sales and Commission: Carnegie Art Center will receive a 20% commission on any work sold during this exhibition. Any sold artwork must remain until the end of the exhibition and if the purchaser is picking up the work Carnegie Art Center must be notified in advance.

Publicity: The exhibition will be shared with Carnegie Art Center on websites, social media accounts, e-Flashes and press releases sent to various arts organizations and news outlets.

Other: All dates must be adhered to as specified. There can be no changes to any supplied information such as image, title, or price of work after the entry upload deadline.

Risk and Liability: Receipt of your registration fee constitutes agreement by you that there shall be no liability on the part of the Buffalo Society of Artists, its officers or board members for loss, damage or destruction of any art works during the calendar period of the exhibition.

Awards: Awards will be announced on our virtual exhibition at bsacalls.com

Labels: Labels are included with the prospectus. They must be attached to the back of each of the accepted works. Print out labels now.

To Enter Your Work:

- 1. Go to the website http://bsacalls.com.
- 2. Click on the link 2023 BSA Summer Exhibition.
- 3. Click on the link labeled Image Upload Instructions, and print document. The process for entering is the same as in previous uploads at bsacalls.com. Please read the Image Upload Instructions document very carefully.

IMAGE FORMATTING INSTRUCTIONS

Image Formatting:

- images must be in jpg format with a .jpg extension
- image file size minimum is 500 KB, maxiumum file size is 4 MB, **RGB color is preferred**
- each image should be at least 1200 pixels on a side, at 300 DPI

Image Filename Protocol:

- Two-dimensional work: Submit one full view image (without frame) of the work. Follow this filename setup: First Initial Last Name_Title.jpg
 - example: JKursten_FallLandscape01.jpg
- Three-dimensional work: Submit one full view image of each work.
 You may also submit up to three (3) additional views of each work.

Follow this filename setup: First Initial Last Name_Title.jpg

- example: Jkursten_AgeOfBronze01.jpg
- example: Jkursten_AgeOfBronzedetail01.jpg
- example: Jkursten_AgeOfBronzedetail02.jpg
